The Executive Director must be a collaborative, strategic leader who will sustain Veggielution's strong community presence and implement the organization's new strategic plan with energy, compassion, and skill.



ORGANIZATION BACKGROUND

Founded in 2008, Veggielution connects thousands of San José residents each year through programs that cultivate community building, experiential learning, and deep connection. The organization is rooted in the Emma Prusch Farm Park in the Mayfair neighborhood of East San José, CA. Through its three key program platforms—Food Sovereignty, Community Engagement, and Environmental Education—Veggielution works with its East San José neighbors to ensure that they experience a richness of community life and health that combats social isolation and provides the support needed to create more robust social networks and take positive action in the community.

With an annual budget of \$3.5M, Veggielution's goal is to engage residents throughout Santa Clara County (CA) to build a more equitable and sustainable food system, with a special emphasis on fostering community and family engagement in the low-income, working immigrant community of East San José. Through shared conversations and experiences, healthy food and outdoor learning, Veggielution helps to build social capital in East San José and change attitudes and policies affecting low-income residents by strengthening diverse and multicultural social networks.

Veggielution is one of five anchor organizations in the Mayfair neighborhood of East San José that comprise the Sí Se Puede Collective (SSPC). Other members include Amigos de Guadalupe, Grail Family Services, the School of Arts and Culture at MHP, and SOMOS Mayfair. The SSPC formalizes the shared commitment of these organizations to serve low-income families living in the Mayfair community. By coordinating the work of these organizations, the SSPC aims to enhance the community safety net and to produce a much greater positive impact in the community than any one organization could generate alone.





POSITION OVERVIEW

Veggielution seeks an experienced leader to push the organization toward newly adopted strategic objectives and sustain its mission to connect people from diverse backgrounds through food and farming to build community in East San José.

The Executive Director will support staff and community members as the central face, voice, and heart of the organization. They will be responsible for stewarding the ongoing operations and financial health of the organization, as well as executing long-term strategy and ensuring sustainability. They will lead a dedicated team of staff and volunteers, collaborate with and develop an active and engaged Board of Directors, oversee program development and implementation, and maintain strong relationships with partners and the community.

- An ability to respectfully listen and work with a community of primarily low-income, working immigrant families and individuals, including Spanish language first situations.
- An active knowledge of programs and services that uplift economic mobility, agency, and belonging, and demonstrated striving for positive and permanent change in communities similar to those in Mayfair and greater East San José.
- A strong commitment to the vision of the Sí Se Puede Collective to uplift the dreams, gifts, and talents of Mayfair residents.
- A demonstrated commitment to anti-racism and advancing diversity, equity, and inclusion.

- A visionary leader with the capacity to articulate a clear, long-term vision, build upon the strong foundation of Veggielution's success, and seize new opportunities to deepen impact while remaining responsive to changing conditions.

- An excellent and persuasive communicator with exceptional written, oral, interpersonal, and presentation skills, and the ability to foster an inclusive atmosphere where voices at all levels are acknowledged.
- A confident public speaker who is able to represent Veggielution's interests in the media and with external audiences as the primary face and public spokesperson for the organization.

The ideal Executive Director will have a strong background in management and leadership, including a track record of progressive leadership positions with effective operational and financial oversight, successful fundraising, community engagement, and management of dynamic programs and innovations to drive connection and impact. They must be motivated by a clear and driving passion for food systems, community, and partnership.

The ideal candidate may come from a variety of career pathways. Excellent executive leadership and interpersonal skills are essential, including staff leadership and development, a diplomatic approach to collaborating with the board, and the ability to cultivate strong relationships with partners, individuals, and within the community. The successful candidate will be a strategic leader with the ability to manage a nonprofit organization, fulfill a strategic plan, and provide a daily model of compassionate servant leadership. Experience with community engagement, farm management, agriculture, community farming, and food production is highly preferred.
