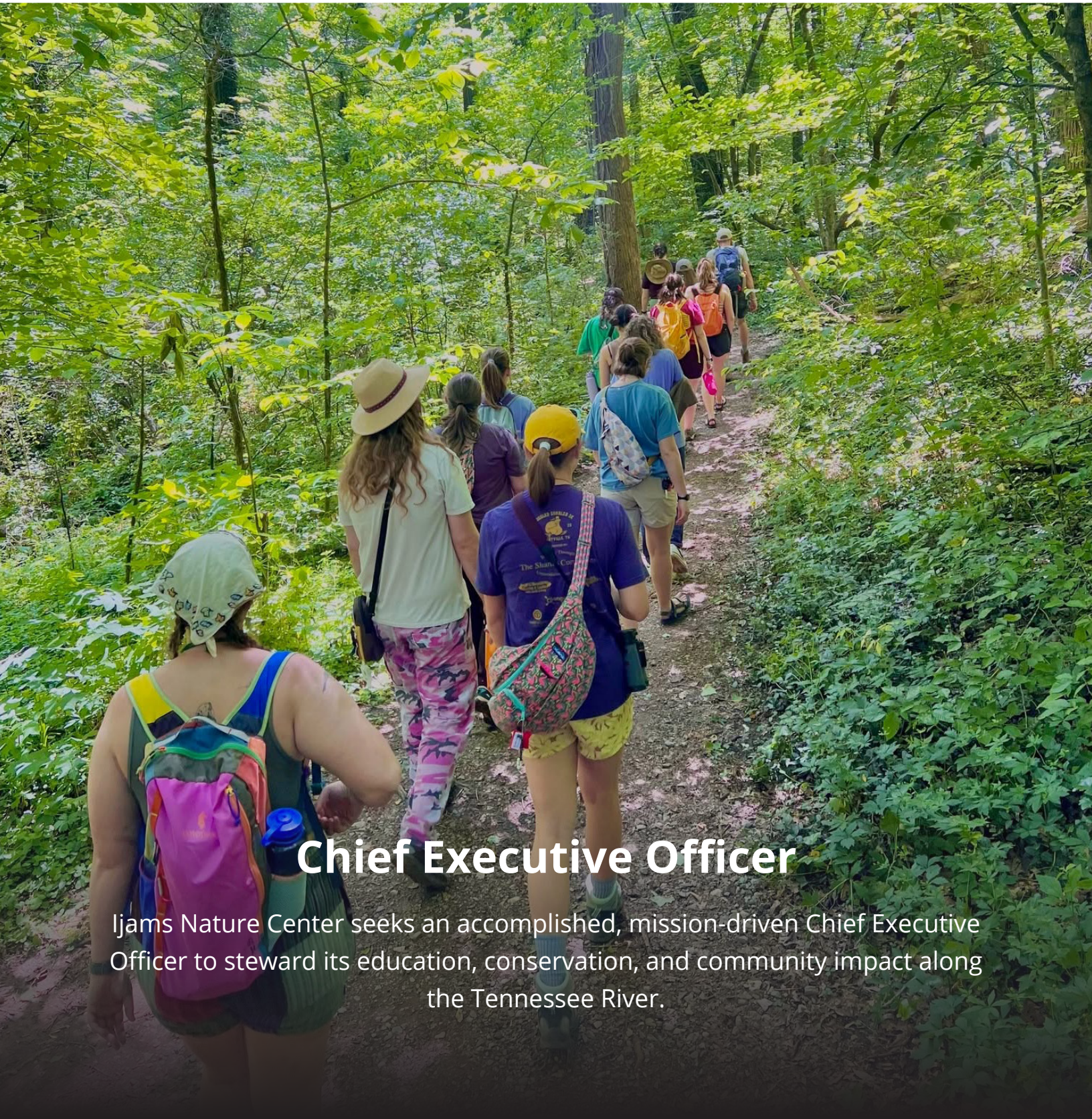

Organization Overview

Ijams Nature Center is a nationally respected nonprofit natural area and nature center located along the Tennessee River near downtown Knoxville, Tennessee. As one of the region's most significant urban green spaces, Ijams connects hundreds of thousands of people each year to the natural world through environmental education, land conservation, outdoor recreation, and community partnerships.

Ijams operates at the intersection of education, conservation, public access, and civic life. It features an integrated system of trails, river access, quarry lake recreation, educational facilities, gardens, and public gathering spaces, spanning more than 336 acres of protected land. Its programs reach learners of all ages, from school field trips and early-learning programs to adult education, conservation initiatives, and large-scale community events. The organization works closely with the City of Knoxville, Knox County, regional partners, and national networks to advance the stewardship of natural resources while ensuring that nature remains accessible and relevant in a rapidly growing urban region. As a defining component of Knoxville's nationally known Urban Wilderness, Ijams is both a beloved community asset and a regional destination.

About Knoxville

Located in East Tennessee, Knoxville is a dynamic and growing city nestled in the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains. The region offers exceptional access to outdoor recreation, including its proximity to Great Smoky Mountains National Park, the most visited national park in the United States, and Big South Fork National River and Recreation Area, known for its dramatic landscapes, trails, and backcountry experiences.

Knoxville is a community that deeply values nature, conservation, and outdoor access, with residents embracing an active lifestyle and lending strong public support to preserving and expanding natural spaces. Along the city's south waterfront, it is home to the nationally recognized Urban Wilderness, a 1,000-acre outdoor adventure area. It features an extensive network of trails and greenways that connect users to a wildlife area, lakes, quarries, historic sites, playgrounds, city parks, and Ijams Nature Center. Outdoor enthusiasts can hike, bike, climb, paddle, or stroll, all within minutes of downtown.

It offers a thriving arts and culture scene, an expanding food and local business community, and a flagship research institution in the University of Tennessee.
