- Stay current on best practices in network management and CoPs
- Seek opportunities to grow the impact of the CoP and connect members to each other in creative ways
- Help people navigate the greater systems field effectively and provide access to systems tools, resources, and opportunities for growth and development

- Capable of facilitating complex discussions while contributing to initiatives where systems thinking methodologies are employed, even without being the foremost expert
